
MBEF 2022 Community Survey of Parents


Response to Survey

The MBEF was sent the survey to all parents at the elementary, middle school and high school levels.




Awareness of Limited MBUSD State Funding


Awareness of MBEF and its Purpose

The vast majority MBUSD parents are familiar with MBEF and its focus on supplementing state funding to bring more opportunities to our students.




Familiarity with MBEF Funded Programs

Our community is very familiar with the programs funded by MBEF at every school level, particularly at the elementary school sites.




MBEF's Impact on Quality of Education

The majority of parents agree that MBEF is important to maintaining the quality of education at MBUSD public schools.




How MBEF Impacts Our Schools and Community

Parents at all grade levels are in agreement that MBEF impacts our schools and community in many critical ways.




Parent Program Priorities – Elementary


Parent Program Priorities – Middle School

Middle school parents also prioritized class size as their top priority, followed by music instruction and support through counselors. Enhancing electives to provide exploratory learning pathways is also a priority.




Parent Program Priorities – High School

High school parents also prioritized class size as their top priority, followed by more support from counselors and the College and Career Center. Enhancing electives to provide advanced options in all fields is also a priority.




Priorities for Future Funding – Elementary


Priorities for Future Funding – Middle School


Priorities for Future Funding – High School


Educational Events
