THE VISION



The Manhattan Beach Education Foundation is a community driven fundraising organization, which supplements state funding for programs that inspire learning, enrich teaching, and promote innovation and academic excellence in the public schools of Manhattan Beach.

GREAT SCHOOLS START WITH A STRONG FOUNDATION

MBEF was founded in 1983 by a small group of parents committed to strengthening Manhattan Beach public schools. At that time, school funding was at an all-time low and private donations were critical to providing a quality education for our children. MBEF has continued to provide a means for the Manhattan Beach community to invest in superior public education for all students.

Today, our strong public schools are an integral part of our vibrant and dynamic community, but the need for local support to supplement state funding is just as critical as ever. Despite an increase in the budget for education over the years, our public schools still do not receive the level of funding required to provide an exceptional, well-rounded education to meet the needs of our students. Donations to MBEF continue to be a significant part of supporting — in small or large part — nearly every academic pursuit and enrichment opportunity across all campuses.

THE NEED



Our Manhattan Beach schools are among the best in the state and country. But despite high property taxes, our per pupil funding for education is different from most other high performing districts. Donations to MBEF each year are critical to provide the enriched education that our parents expect, and our students need, to succeed.

Without additional support from MBEF, many of the robust learning programs and specialized educator positions that shape the exceptional education in our district would be eliminated. These are the unique programs that support 21st century teaching and learning and challenge our students to think critically and creatively. 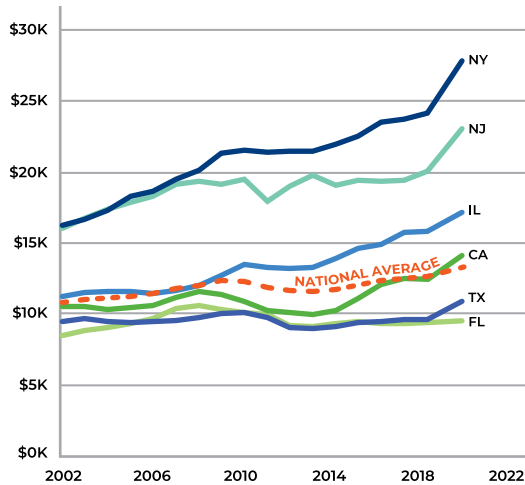
DECADES OF INADEQUATE STATE FUNDING

Funding for California public schools has been insufficient for decades — to this day

it barely funds the basics, not the enriched educational opportunities that we expect. At one time California was ranked 5th in the nation in per pupil funding, but the passage of Proposition 13 in 1978 dramatically shifted how the state funds education, ultimately moving California to 48th in the nation at its all-time low. California has slowly been building its funding support of education over the past 10 years and has only recently surpassed the national average. Depending on the report, California's per-pupil funding falls anywhere between 19th to 35th if adjusted for the high cost of living. Because of its heavy reliance on state tax revenue, California's education funding is

more volatile than other states – it falls fast during recessions and rises more quickly during economic recoveries. Local funding sources such as parcel taxes and education foundations have been critical to ensuring consistency in maintaining high-quality public schools throughout the state.

HISTORY OF STATE EDUCATION PER-PUPIL FUNDING



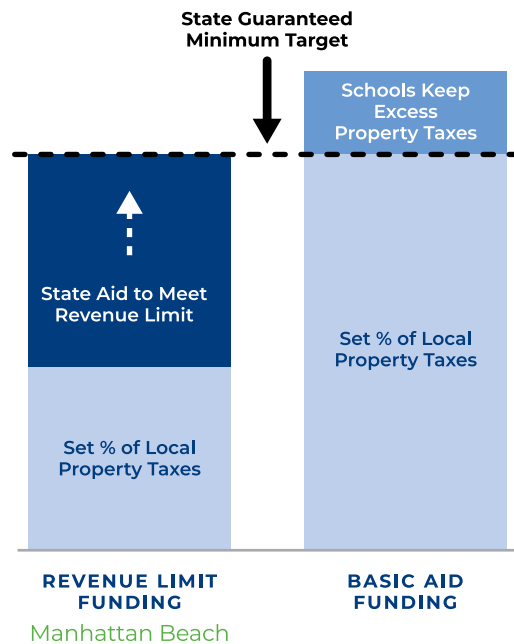
OUR FUNDING LIMITATIONS IN MANHATTAN BEACH

The assumption that our property tax dollars adequately fund public education is simply not true. Despite advancements in California’s education funding levels, Manhattan Beach continues to struggle, receiving roughly \$2,000 below the statewide average before local support. Proposition 13 and subsequent rulings capped the percentage of property taxes allocated to education at a time when Manhattan Beach schools served grades K-8 only. Consequently, less than 20% of property taxes raised in Manhattan Beach are allocated to fund our local schools –

making MBUSD a Revenue Limit district and dependent on state funding to reach the minimum target set by the state for per pupil funding.

Basic Aid districts, such as Palo Alto and Laguna Beach, funded education at a higher level when Prop 13 was enacted, and therefore receive a larger portion of local tax dollars. These Basic Aid districts retain the excess property tax dollars above the state target, resulting in significantly higher per pupil funding. Converting to a Basic Aid district is a possibility, but it only occurs when the percentage of property tax dollars allocated to education in a district exceeds the per-pupil target from the state. In the case of Manhattan Beach, this will likely occur in the next 12-15 years, when local property

tax revenues increase to a point where 20% is well above the state distribution. Local education leaders have advocated for changing the funding structure with the State Legislature over the years, but protecting the benefits of Proposition 13 has been a significant priority for the state.

LOCAL CONTROL FUNDING FORMULA SUPPORTS EQUITY, NOT ADEQUACY

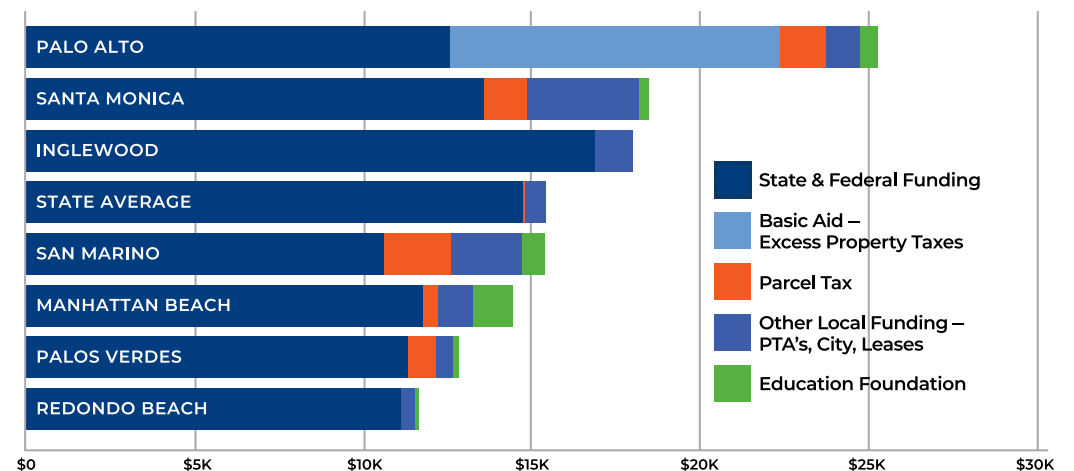
The Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) was adopted in 2013 to provide supplemental support of public-school districts with greater numbers of high need students. These districts require additional funding to support costs associated with programs like Free and Reduced Lunch and English Language Learners. Very few students qualify for these programs in MBUSD or other neighboring school districts, and therefore they do not receive significant supplemental funding. Creating equity among California students is essential, but the base level of education funding

has remained inadequate for all students. The chart below depicts the stark variation in funding among districts and demonstrates how impactful local support can be on per-pupil funding.

BUDGET CHALLENGES REMAIN

Our community has supplemented state funding for years and despite the recent increase in the state budget, the need for local support remains constant. Much of the increase in funding is either one-time to combat challenges brought on by the pandemic or directed to particular spending categories, limiting control to meet local needs. In addition, California’s already declining K-12 student enrollment due to falling birth rates and net migration has been further impacted by COVID-19. Plus, the local burden to cover the growing costs of pensions, healthcare, and other mandated services is outpacing school funding from the state. Ultimately, local support remains critical to meet the needs of our Manhattan Beach students.

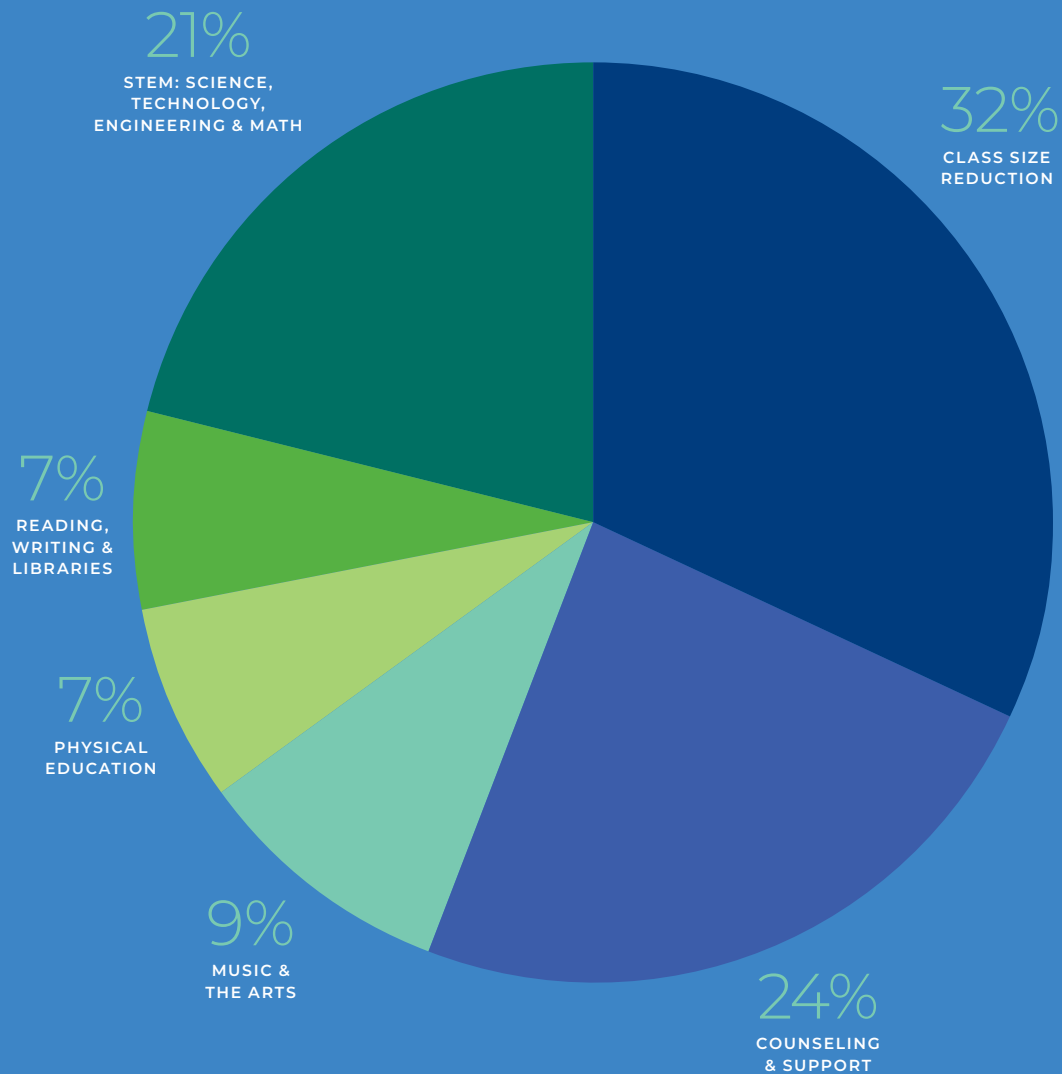
The combination of this support has grown into a multi-million-dollar commitment that has an impressive impact on student learning. MBEF’s Grants Committee, comprising MBEF Board Members representing all school sites, works with

district and school leadership, educators, and parents and students to identify priorities that are most aligned with MBEF’s mission.

While the vast majority of MBEF funding is committed to continuing successful long-term grants and teaching positions, MBEF considers the possibility of adding new programs if funding allows.

For the 2022-2023 school year, MBEF will grant over \$6.1 million to fund exceptional opportunities in our schools, including several new programs and positions that will benefit all students.

MBEF's commitment continues to ensure our students have access to a strong, well-rounded academic program and an array of enrichment opportunities. This year, several new MBEF programs and educator positions have been identified that will expand our impact on student success.

CLASS SIZE REDUCTION

\$1,965,000 | 32% OF OVERALL FUNDING

Few educational practices have the potential for greater impact than learning in a classroom with fewer students. Both parents and teachers consistently prioritize the importance of Class Size Reduction (CSR) as instrumental in a student's educational experience. MBEF is able to support lower class sizes in general, and also allocate significant funding to ensure that the number of students is lower in specific core classes in critical grade levels.

GENERAL CLASS SIZE REDUCTION (4-12): \$865,000

While state guidelines provide for a maximum of 24 students per class in grades TK-3, there are no maximums in grades 4-12. Without restrictions or adequate state funding, our schools depend on support from MBEF to ensure more reasonable class sizes in all subjects for grades 4-12.

ELEMENTARY CLASS SIZE REDUCTION (4-5): \$250,000

In addition to the General CSR above, MBEF provides funding that ensures a maximum of 30 students per class in grades 4-5. Students at this age are beginning to define their strengths, as well as their challenge areas. Keeping class sizes smaller allows teachers to personalize their support of each student to ensure their growth and achievement in all areas.

ENGLISH/HUMANITIES & MATH CLASS SIZE REDUCTION (6-8): \$250,000

MBEF directs CSR funding toward reducing class size specifically in English/Humanities and Math in grades 6-8.

The transition to middle school can be challenging, and providing more space for differentiated learning in core subjects ensures our students have the support that they need. This directed grant ensures that the average class size is 30 students for these critical subjects.

ENGLISH & MATH CLASS SIZE REDUCTION (9): \$250,000

MBEF also directs CSR funding towards reducing class size specifically in English and Math in 9th grade to ensure the average number of students is 30 in each class. This provides more individual attention in these critical core subjects to better equip them with a solid foundation as they progress through high school.

ZERO PERIOD (9-12): \$350,000

This grant provides all Mira Costa students with the option to add an extra period to their schedule to fulfill course requirements and benefit from the array of additional elective course options. More than 30% of MCHS students take advantage of the additional period each day.



COUNSELING & SUPPORT

\$1,484,500 | 24% OF OVERALL FUNDING

The COVID-19 pandemic elevated levels of stress, anxiety and depression in students throughout the country at an unprecedented rate. In the California Healthy Kids Survey, a confidential survey of school climate and safety, student wellness, and youth resiliency, 35% of MBUSD students in grades 7, 9 and 11 have experienced chronic sadness in the past twelve months. It is more important than ever to provide our students with both the advocates and tools to help recognize and cope with their emotional wellness and academic success.

ENHANCED! SCHOOL COUNSELORS (6-12): \$835,000

Counselors foster a sense of connection on campus and play an essential role in guiding students in their planning. The average student to counselor ratio in California schools is exceptionally high at 680:1, well beyond the American School Counselor Association's recommendation of 250:1. MBEF's growing investment in counseling has played a critical role in adequately supporting the needs of students. This year MBEF will fund two

additional counselors for both the middle and high school to decrease the student-to-counselor ratio to 300:1. Our counselors will have more time to mentor students on time management and organization, connect on individual needs, and monitor academic progress.

COLLEGE AND CAREER CENTER COUNSELORS (9-12): \$275,000

MBEF funds the experts in the MCHS College and Career Center (CCC) who are devoted to helping our high school

students navigate the college application process and define post-graduation pathways. From individual meetings and application assessment, to hosting college admission visits and other events on-campus, to an abundance of resources and materials on hand at the CCC, this program is an essential part of helping our students make the right personal choice for their next step upon graduation. Parents are welcome to take advantage of the extensive CCC services as well, with both day and evening appointments available.

MBMS ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL (6-8): \$150,000

Having an additional administrator at Manhattan Beach Middle School helps support the vast needs of a large, thriving middle school. From helping to manage the overall operations, to overseeing teachers and curriculum, to ensuring the safety of the students, the administration is an essential part of MBMS' success. The additional support from MBEF ensures that there are more minds and hands at work to improve the school environment.

NEW! STUDENT SUCCESS TEACHER ON SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT (TOSA) (6-8): \$125,000

Middle school is a challenging time that requires significant mentoring and support as students explore their interests and focus on development. This TOSA will work on building academic success and a climate of care to better meet the diverse needs of our students at a critical transition in their lives. The Student Success TOSA will lead programs such as the nationally recognized mentoring program, Where Everybody Belongs (WEB), and coordinate

professional development for staff, learning experiences for all students, and parent partnerships.

NEW! STUDENT SUCCESS PROGRAM SUPPORT (6-8): \$25,000

Program funding for curriculum, materials, guest speakers, and other essentials related to the implementation of the Student Success Program at Manhattan Beach Middle School.

ENHANCED! EDUCATOR GRANTS (TK-12): \$70,000

The MBEF Educator Grant Program was created to support excellence in our schools by empowering MBUSD educators with funding to implement projects that will enhance teaching and learning throughout the district. The program provides educators with the opportunity to re-define best practices, explore innovative and inclusive approaches to instruction, collaborate and partner with colleagues, and connect the wealth of knowledge, expertise and talent within the MBUSD community. All MBUSD teachers, counselors and administrators are encouraged to apply for these small grants at the start of the year, to be implemented immediately upon approval.

TEACHER OF THE YEAR AWARDS (TK-12): \$4,500

Each year, MBUSD recognizes one teacher from each school as the Teacher of the Year, and one of those teachers is selected as the Districtwide Teacher of the Year. With this grant, made possible by an endowment fund sponsored by the Nickell Family, all of MBUSD's Teachers of the Year receive a small monetary reward.



MUSIC & THE ARTS

\$515,000 | 9% OF OVERALL FUNDING

A quality visual and performing arts education is an essential part of a comprehensive academic program for all students. Art education fosters lifelong learning skills – creativity, collaboration, communication, critical thinking, and problem solving – and improves the psychological and creative aptitudes of all students. Our students have the option to participate in sequential and comprehensive arts education programs that encourage active learning and a deeper appreciation of the arts.

MUSIC PROGRAM (1-12): \$415,000

MBEF supports music instruction in grades 1-12, and as a result, the music program at MBUSD has flourished. Students in grades 1-5 are introduced to a comprehensive music program with instruction in vocal, wind and string instruments. Taught by certificated music instructors, the program fosters a love of music and serves as the foundation for our award-winning middle and high school programs. At the secondary level, students can specialize in the instrument of their choice and participate in a variety of award-winning programs.

NEW! ARTS ELECTIVE ENHANCEMENT (6-12): \$100,000

The enhanced elective program in middle and high school offers students a wide range of electives. Specialized courses in visual and performing arts, such as Advanced Film, Ceramics, Cinematic Arts, Drama, Printmaking, Technical Theater, and Yearbook, are offered to encourage interest in either exploring or becoming proficient in an art.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

\$450,000 | 7% OF OVERALL FUNDING

MBEF is proud to support credentialed physical education teachers at our elementary schools to provide high-quality physical education and sportsmanship instruction each week. In addition to the physical health benefits, research shows that physical activity can help children improve their concentration, memory, and classroom behavior. Without certificated PE Specialists, MBUSD classroom teachers would need to incorporate the state-required 100 minutes into their weekly instruction. These specialized PE teachers also serve as mentors on the fields and playgrounds during recess and lunch, coordinating structured outlets for student to engage in organized activities and games.

READING, WRITING & LIBRARIES

\$450,000 | 7% OF OVERALL FUNDING

Literacy is a critical part of learning for all students and lays the foundation for future success. Our educators have prioritized literacy in our students, personalizing support at every level. In addition to the curriculum in the classroom, our students have access to a dedicated campus library with additional support to focus on developing this key tenet of learning.

NEW! LITERACY TEACHER ON SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT (TOSA) (TK-12): \$125,000

MBEF helps ensure that MBUSD curriculum keeps pace with the changing world by funding a TOSA to lead continuous improvement efforts throughout the district in this important area of growth. Under the direction of the TOSA, student achievement is evident in participation in advanced courses and electives, including Creative Writing, Journalism, and AP English, as well as our exceptional scores on standardized tests districtwide.

LIBRARY RESOURCE SPECIALISTS (TK-8): \$325,000

Having access to a school library and knowing how to access credible sources using technology provides endless discoveries for students. MBEF supports Library Resource Specialists at the elementary and middle school grade levels to help develop research and media literacy skills and foster a passion for reading, learning and research that will serve them throughout their lives. The libraries have become a hub of information on each campus, providing students with a quiet place to read during recess and lunch, and a vibrant center for research and learning.

STEM: SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING & MATH

\$1,255,000 | 21% OF OVERALL FUNDING

Project-based learning in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) for students at the elementary, middle and high school levels has been a significant priority for our community. If our students are to compete in today's global economy, we must provide a solid, hands-on foundation in STEM education. The important foundational concepts learned in STEM-based classrooms and programs promote strategic critical thinking and creative problem-solving to ensure our students can navigate and engage in a 21st century global society.

ELEMENTARY MATH TEACHER ON SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT (TOSA) (TK-5): \$125,000

The adoption of Common Core State Standards for Math in 2010 introduced a new way of teaching and learning math. The focus on both mathematical understanding and procedural skill as equally important means modeling new concepts for students that go beyond memorizing formulas. The Math TOSA at the elementary level will continue to strengthen instruction with teachers by modeling teaching techniques and practices, while also coordinating common student assessments to address student learning needs.

NEW! SECONDARY MATH TEACHER ON SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT (TOSA) (6-12): \$80,000

Students in our secondary schools today learned the Common Core approach to math while in elementary school. Focusing on aligning teaching and learning in our secondary schools will help to strengthen math instruction and outcomes districtwide. MBEF will augment MBUSD funds for a Teacher on Special Assignment (TOSA) to collaborate on student-driven instruction and best practices in instruction with teachers across the

mathematics departments at the middle and high school.

NEW! STEM TEACHER ON SPECIAL ASSIGNMENT (TOSA) (TK-12): \$125,000

Strengthening the STEM program and enhancing the available articulation pathways requires resources to identify and implement best practices as they evolve with industry standards. A directed gift from Chevron will fund a Teacher on Special Assignment (TOSA) to lead the districtwide efforts in STEM and ensure the natural progression from elementary to high school. The TOSA will collaborate with all STEM educators to create synergy between the school sites.

NEW! STEM PROGRAM SUPPORT (TK-12): \$125,000

Program funding for curriculum, materials and collaboration related to the implementation of districtwide STEM programs.

MAKERSPACE SPECIALISTS (TK-5): \$150,000

The unique MakerSpace environments throughout our elementary schools provide innovative lab experiences for our students in grades TK-5. Empowering students to learn problem-solving skills through trial



and error and see themselves as inventors, helps develop a student's ability to think creatively and visualize solutions. MBEF funds MakerSpace Specialists who support program implementation by preparing materials, facilitating lessons, and organizing the Maker Labs.

SCIENCE SPECIALISTS (TK-5): \$410,000

This grant supports credentialed science teachers to provide all elementary students with hands-on lab experiences and project-based learning opportunities that strengthen students' passion for science. Trained in the nationally recognized Project Lead the Way (PLTW), the specialists engage students in real-world learning that connects the classroom science curriculum with engaging, hands-on activities, projects and problems.

NEW! STEM PATHWAYS (6-8): \$150,000

MBEF has been at the forefront of pioneering programs that challenge even our youngest students with hands-on learning in MakerSpace and Science

Lab. As students progress to middle school, our hope is that their passion for STEM will continue to flourish with new and exciting pathways that will bridge into advanced high school programs. MBEF supports a year-long STEM elective for students in grades 7-8 funded by Northrop Grumman, as well as a STEM wheel option with a focus on FabLab, Marine Biology and STEM. New for the coming year is a year-long FabLab elective option for grades 7-8, as well as a dedicated unit on STEM built into grade 6 Science.

SCIENCE LAB ASSISTANT (9-12): \$90,000

The Science Lab Assistant at MCHS provides critical support for our lab science teachers by preparing materials and resources to make lab instruction organized, efficient and innovative. With a recent shift in staffing, more support is required this year to ensure the continued success of the program through training.

THE ENDOWMENT



The MBEF Endowment provides MBEF with a continuing and sustainable funding source that will expand and enhance the quality of public education in Manhattan Beach, now and for generations to come.

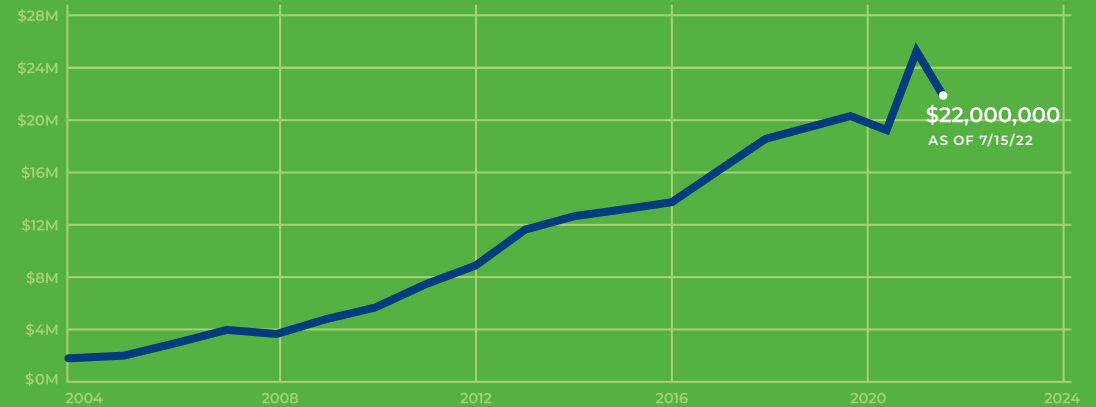
The MBEF Endowment helps serve our school community with a sustainable source of funding by providing an annual disbursement that supports immediate program needs while still preserving the principle of the investment. The Endowment's annual return on investment continues to grow as the principle grows, helping to make up for the instability of public-school funding at the state level.

For over 30 years, generous gifts from supporters, and strong long-term investment returns, have fueled the MBEF Endowment balance. Under the Endowment Disbursement Policy, which follows the prudent standards outlined

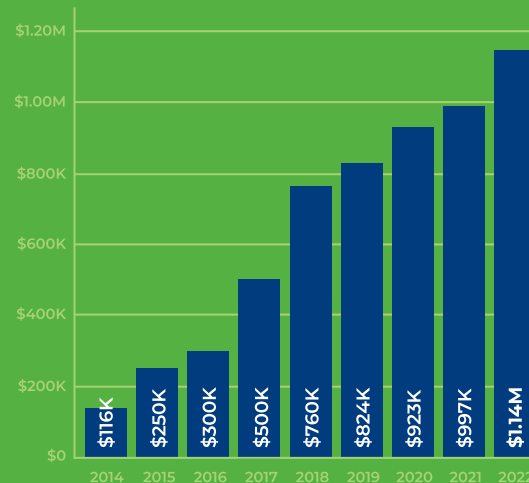
in the Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act of 2006 ("UPMIFA"), the balance allowed the Endowment to distribute over \$1 million this year. Because the policy takes into consideration a three-year average, the impact of short-term fluctuations in the market is limited.

We are grateful to those individuals who had the foresight to establish the MBEF Endowment with just \$10,000 in 1986, and to all of the dedicated donors who have helped it grow since. The MBEF Endowment will continue to strengthen our schools for years to come, while also helping to send today's students into the world with the skills they need to become the next generation of leaders.

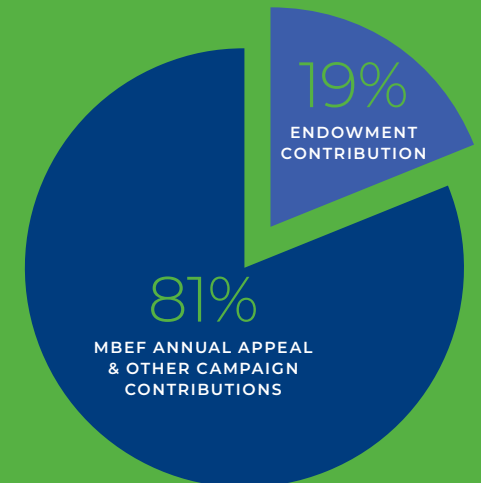
ENDOWMENT GROWTH

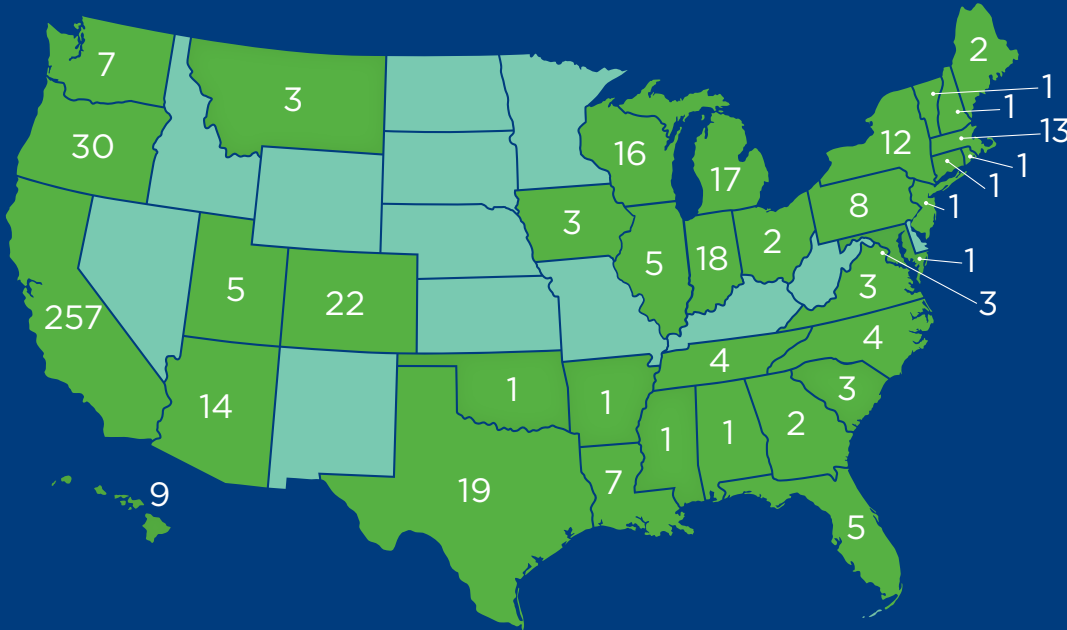

To ensure effective planning, the results of our fundraising efforts in one year fund the grants of the following year – meaning that the funding raised from the 2021-22 Annual Appeal will fund the programs in the 2022-23 school year. For the coming year, MBEF will grant over \$6.1 million to our schools based on our fundraising success in 2021-2022. Our community’s generosity makes this possible through a variety of funding sources that all add up to strengthen our schools.

The MBEF Board of Directors and staff ensure the principled stewardship of donor funds to maximize the grants to MBUSD schools for the benefit of all students. MBEF undergoes a full audit each year and maintains an Audit Committee comprised of MBEF board members and independent finance professionals who review the financials annually.

MBEF’s strong financial health, accountability and transparency has earned the highest honors from both Charity Navigator and Candid, formerly GuideStar, who evaluate non-profits to ensure the good governance and integrity of the organization.
